Read the following passage and then answer the questions that follow.

Mount Everest

Mount Everest is the highest mountain in the world. It is over 60 million years old, and it is 8, 848 meters high. The rocky summit (top) of this mountain is covered with snow all year round.

Over four thousand people have tried to reach the summit of Mount Everest, but less than a thousand people have been successful. Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norgay were the first men to reach the top of this mountain in 1953. It took them seven weeks to reach the top of Mount Everest. When they reached the summit, they looked down and saw the surrounding countries of Tibet, India, and Nepal.

Climbing Mount Everest is a dangerous expedition. A person who plans to climb Mount Everest needs to be fit and healthy. Moreover, a trip to Mount Everest is very expensive and costs a lot of money. A climber needs to spend a lot of money on special clothing, climbing equipment, and food. Climbers usually ask travel guides to help them reach the summit. Climbers have to pay these guides a lot of money, too.

Sadly, many climbers die before they reach the summit of Mount Everest. Some die because of sickness. Others die because they trip and fall into deep holes. Some die because it is too cold on the mountain. Many die because of avalanches. When an avalanche happens, large amounts of snow fall down the mountain. The snow buries the climbers. About a hundred and sixty bodies are still on the mountain, buried beneath layers of snow. It is too difficult and dangerous to remove these dead bodies.

The air at the top of Mount Everest is thinner than air that is at the bottom of the mountain. Oxygen levels at the top of Mount Everest are low, too. This makes breathing very **difficult**. For this reason, climbers should slowly climb the mountain over a two-month period. By doing this, their bodies gradually get used to the thin air. To help them breathe, climbers should wear oxygen masks. They should also wear thick **puffy** clothing filled with goose feathers to stay warm.
